



- Each group must be pre-registered and be paid in full to participate. Groups are registered on a first come first serve basis with **a maximum of 12 groups will be accepted.**
- All participants must be under 18 years of age on June 6th 2009 to qualify. Please bring ID, it may be required
- A fee of \$5 per person is required in advance, which includes entrance to the park on Saturday. Anyone moving on to the finals will receive free Park admission for Sunday as well.
- Each group will be asked to pre- select & practice 2 songs in any 1 (one) level, which will then be performed at the Semi-final round Saturday June 6th @ The Streetsville Bread & Honey Festival 2009 (see site map details attached)
- All groups must check-in at the on-site registration booth Saturday June 6th by 2:45 pm to receive their performance time, waiver and have ID checked
- All groups must check-in and be ready to perform 15 minutes prior to their performance time
- Each group of 4 must be complete at time of performance. If a group cannot perform, at their allotted time (a 5 minute grace period will be allowed), they will have to forfeit. If a group has a forfeit but **is** able to perform the second song, they will be allowed to do so.
- Groups will be Judged by a panel of judges, including their peers, in the following categories;
25% Costume & Originality, 25% Rock Star Stage Presence & 50% Sound & Technical (as determined by the game and based on an average of the two songs performed)
- The scores are final as recorded by the official score keeper at the time of the Jam., and determined by the judges.
- All finalists will be posted no later than **7:30pm** Saturday June 6th on the board outside the performance tent – finalists will also be contacted by phone
- Finalist will receive an information package with FREE admission tickets for Sunday.

Finalists

- All groups must arrive back to the tent and register no later than 12:45pm Sunday June 7th, 2009. You will then be assigned a performance time. Each group must be complete at performance time to avoid a forfeit
- Finalists will choose one of the two songs performed on the previous day. Please have this information ready when you register.
- The finalists will compete against the best in their level. Judges will award a score out of 100 for overall performance and that will be added to the score from the game to get the overall score.
- The Top Group in each level will win a Cash prize as follows;
Expert Level - \$400
Hard level -\$300
Medium-\$200
- The decisions of the judges and the official score keeper are final
